

Teen Driver Emergency Guide

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Print this checklist and keep it in your glove box. In an emergency, work top to bottom.

- Pull off the road — never stop in a traffic lane
- Turn on hazard lights the moment something feels wrong
- Call a parent or guardian first, then roadside assistance
- Do not accept help from strangers — stay in the vehicle with doors locked
- Share your live location with a trusted contact
- Know the make, model, color, and license plate of your vehicle
- Keep insurance and registration in the glove box
- Carry a charged phone and a backup power bank
- Never attempt to change a tire on a freeway shoulder alone
- Program 1-877-GOAPE-02 into your phone before you drive

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
